**Private, 1946, 1st Battalion, Essex Regiment.  
Died of wounds 13 October 1916.**

**Born Upper Kirby, enlisted Colchester, resident Lower Kirby, Essex  
Brother of Mr A.Mann of Lower Kirby, Essex**

**Buried in DARTMOOR CEMETERY, BECORDEL – BECOURT, Somme, France  
Plot II.Row D. Grave 64**

**Research note:** Although shown resident in Walton in 1901 all the family except young Willie were born in Kirby-le-Soken. The CWGC record shows that Frederick was brother to **A. Mann**. and this record shows an older brother as **Arthur Mann** so this may be the **Frederick Mann** (who worked on a farm at Kirby) I am looking for.
